VOICE OF THE SHEPHERD

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we begin the New Year with the joyful celebration of January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God, we entrust our lives, our families, and our Diocese to her loving intercession. Mary, the humble handmaid of the Lord, stands close to the poor and the marginalized. From the manger of Bethlehem to the foot of the Cross, she teaches us that faith is lived through humility, trust in God, and compassionate service to those in need.

Guided by this Marian spirit, the Jubilee Year 2025 became a year of faith translated into concrete action in the Diocese of Kuzhithurai. Along with educational assistance, medical aid, marriage financial assistance, and pension schemes for the elderly, our Jubilee celebrations took a historic and people-centred turn through the Diocesan Housing Mission. Every parish was invited to build a house for a poor and deserving family. I gratefully acknowledge the generous response of our priests and lay faithful. Through your solidarity, cooperation, and generous support, 51 new houses were constructed and 30 houses renovated, with a total expenditure of nearly ₹ 4 crores, raised entirely through parish contributions. These houses were built not only for Catholics but also for families belonging to other religions and denominations, reflecting our commitment to inclusive social responsibility. This mission will continue until no one in our Diocese and the wider Kanyakumari district remains homeless.

On January 14, we celebrate the feast of St. Devasahayam, the patron saint of the Indian laity. His life is a powerful testimony of unwavering faith, courage, and commitment to justice. As a layman, he lived his Christian faith openly, stood for truth, and paid the ultimate price for his convictions.

In recent days, we have witnessed painful incidents in various parts of our country, where Christians were harassed, threatened, and prevented from celebrating Christmas peacefully. Such acts of

intolerance and violence wound the fabric of our nation and stand against the spirit of our Constitution and the teachings of all true religions. As a Church, we firmly condemn all forms of hatred and persecution, while choosing the path of Christ—truth, forgiveness, and steadfast commitment to justice and peace.

This month also invites us to rejoice in Pongal, the traditional Tamil harvest festival, a celebration deeply rooted in gratitude to God, nature, and the hard work of farmers. Pongal reminds us of the sacred relationship between humanity and creation, and the importance of living in harmony with the earth. It is a festival that brings families and communities together, transcending differences of religion and social status. In today's context of ecological crisis, Pongal calls us to renew our commitment to environmental responsibility. As people of faith, let us recognize God's providence in the fruits of the earth and recommit ourselves to protecting creation and caring for one another.

May Mary, Mother of God, St. Devasahayam, and the spirit of gratitude symbolized by Pongal guide us throughout this New Year. May our faith continue to find expression in love, service, justice, and unity.

- * Four students received a certificate for scribe assistance to write the public examination.
- * Five individuals got 35 KG rice entitlement.
- * One person received a nomination for membership for Panchayth election
- * One person applied for three-wheel bike, one person on for tailoring certificate, one person for IGP loan and one application for funeral assistance.

III. Care A Child (CAC) Programme:
