This day makes a clarion call to renew our commitment and responsibility towards the elderly to concentrate more on their welfare. I request all the priests, religious and the faithful to meaningfully celebrate this day in your respective families, anbiams and parishes. In order to honour the Grandparents and the Elders, organize programs in various levels.

On this Fourth World Day devoted to them, let us show our tender love for the grandparents and the elder members of our families. Let us spend time with those who are disheartened and no longer have hope in the possibility of happier period of time ahead.

Old age is a special blessing of God. It is our Christian obligation to respect, uphold and render pastoral care to the elders.

In our Kuzhithurai diocese, though we are interested in doing this pastoral ministry to the elderly, the fourth world day for the elderly urges in us a new call to be more vigilant with regard to this divine task.

Catechism

Changing the Way We Care (CTWWC) - Family and Faith

TWWC concept orientation training was conducted for SSVDP members of Yettacode on May 5, 2024, with 8 members participating. The members learned about the new concept of family care and the demerits of children in Child Care Institutions (CCIs). A list of selected vulnerable children was provided to the members for further monitoring and support to ensure safe and nurturing family care.

Pattarivilai and Karankadu parishes, with support from the Parish Council (PC), BIDS, and the Society of St. Vincent De Paul (SSVDP), have taken up the responsibility to monitor and provide further support to the 29 selected vulnerable children after one year of accompaniment by KIDSS. The parishes committed to ensuring that all children within their parishes remain in their own families, ensuring safe family care. A total of 37 members participated in the handing-over program.

A training session on 'Responsible Children' was conducted on May 16, 2024, at KIDSS Kuzhithurai, with 50 children participating. Mr. John Britto led the session using a participatory method, including group discussions and presentations. On the same day, a session on 'Responsible Parent' was organized for parents/caregivers, with 41 parents/caregivers participating. Sr. Margaret led the session, helping parents understand their role in caring for their children.

A Champion meeting was conducted at Thundathuvilai on May 23, 2024, with 18 members participating. A work plan was prepared with them according to their skills and areas of interest.

Training on monitoring and gatekeeping was conducted for the Manguzhi SSVDP members on May 26, 2024. The gatekeeping mechanism was explained to ensure that all children remain under the care of their parents/caregivers. On May 27, 2024, the same training was conducted at Pottetty for selected members of three villages, with 16 members participating. The participants were made to understand the importance of children being cared for with the love and affection of parents/caregivers and the role of selected leaders in preventing child separation.

July 32 2024

The CTWWC concept was shared with the BCC coordination of Yettacode on May 19, 2024, with 14 members, Arockiapuram BIDS on May 5, 2024, with 17 members, and Elampilavilai BIDS on May 19, 2024, with 17 members participating. For VBS children at Pottetty on May 11, 2024, 168 children attended, and in Pullani on May 22, 2024, 112 children attended. In all these meetings, importance was given to family-based care for all children irrespective of poverty.

A follow-up review meeting was conducted with the office bearers of the Parish Council, BIDS, and Champions at Nullivilai parish on May 28, 2024, to review the monitoring mechanism after handing over the children and to discuss the pros and cons of monitoring the children.

The Field Case Managers (FCMs) visited 193 children from 126 families. During their visits, they identified different needs for 37 children and caregivers and took the initiative to guide and support them in responding to their needs through linkages and referrals, as detailed below:

Referral and linkage for welfare assistance for the identified Vulnerable families/ children

- 1. Three individuals applied for PM-JAY ID (CMCHIS).
- 2. Six children were guided to apply for education scholarships under private NGOs, and one student applied for higher education. One student was supported in getting admission to college for higher studies.
- 3. One child was guided and applied for an education scholarship under the Mission Vatsalya scheme.
- 4. One disabled person was referred to the KIDSS disability project and applied for a disability ID card. One special child was supported in getting a free bus pass.
- 5. Four individuals were provided with psychosocial support with the help of counselors, and three caregivers were assisted by FCMs.
- 6. Three individuals applied for and obtained legal documents such as Aadhar corrections and Community certificates, and one person applied for a Social Welfare ID card.

July 2024

- 7. One single parent applied for a widow certificate, and one family was guided to apply under the 'National Social Assistance Programme' (NSAP) for the bereaved family.
- 8. Melpuram SSVDP helped two families with Rs. 2500/- for their livelihood.
- 9. One person applied for and received Rs. 8000/- under the KIDSS ERF scheme for an operation.
- 10. One family was guided and submitted an application for financial assistance to KIDSS and Pottetty Parish for house maintenance.
- 11. Seven applications were given to a Champion for educational support for poor students.

Community Disability Management & Rehabilitation Project (CDM&RP)

A special meeting was organized with disabled individuals on May 26, 2024, at St. Mary's Basilica Church campus, Mulagumoodu, with 12 members participating. Fr. John Michael Raj, the Executive Director, emphasized the need to form a group exclusively for the disabled at the diocesan level to ensure active participation in liturgy and other common programs. The participants were very happy and appreciated the initiative to be organized as a group. They decided to start in a few parishes initially, including Chetticharvilai, Kandanvilai, and Kappukadu Villages.

The field staff made a special effort to identify new disabled individuals within our diocese and identified 40 new disabled persons, including 30 with learning disabilities (LD), 7 who are mentally challenged, 2 resulting from strokes, and one person who is hearing impaired. This month, we helped a few people receive the following benefits:

- One person received the monthly pension.
- Three individuals received new privilege cards.
- Two persons obtained free train pass.
- ❖ One application was submitted for the UDID card.

July 34 2024

- ❖ Two applications were submitted for pension scheme and One application was filed to increase the pension amount.
- Three applications were submitted for new privilege cards.
- ❖ Three children are receiving physiotherapy treatment and one adult is undergoing speech therapy supported by the project.

KIDSS Activities

KIDSS All-staff meeting was conducted on May 30, 2024, with 27 staff participating, except for one. In the morning, all staff attended the Kids Bank branch opening program at Thickanamcode, and the staff meeting was held in the afternoon. The report was read and approved. A reminder was given to Mr. John Britto to complete the CP conference at the local level in 9 places and to plan for the zonal level CP conference with the team. Panchayat-level trainings were planned on the topic of environmental protection. Information was given to motivate people to participate in the World Drug Day observation on June 26, 2024, at Kanyakumari.

A felicitation was given to the outgoing Executive Director, Fr. John Michael Raj. All unit staff representatives appreciated his tireless work for the development of KIDSS over the last 7 years, especially for his simplicity, availability, and efforts in capacitating the staff towards outcome-based involvements. KIDSS PO Sr. Michealammal highlighted the special efforts and achievements of Executive Director Fr. John Michael Raj during his seven-year term. The special guests were Fr. Martin M., the new Executive Director, and Dr. John Arokiaraj, Tamil Nadu State Officer, Caritas India. Dr. John Arokiaraj also thanked Fr. John Michael Raj for his leadership and active cooperation with partners, especially with Caritas India. Fr. John Michael Raj expressed his deepest gratitude for the opportunity to work with everyone and for their collaboration and support.
