Monthly Recollection



Dear Fathers Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we step into the holy season of Lent on March 5, the Church invites us to embark on a profound journey of interior renewal and conversion. This sacred time is an opportunity to turn back to the Lord with an undivided heart, allowing His grace to penetrate every dimension of our lives. Lent is not merely a tradition; it is a spiritual pilgrimage, echoing the call of Christ: "Repent, and believe in the Gospel" (Mark 1:15). The Church, in her wisdom, provides us with three essential spiritual disciplines to aid us on this journey: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These are not mere obligations but means by which we participate in the mystery of Christ's Paschal sacrifice and open ourselves more fully to the transformative power of His grace.

Prayer is the gateway to communion with God and a journey into the depths of our own soul. In the noise and distractions of daily life, it is easy to drift away from God's presence. Lent calls us to pause, reflect, and return to the Father, much like the prodigal son who, realizing his need for mercy, arose and went back to his father (Luke 15:18-20). True prayer is not only an act of speaking to God but also of listening, allowing His voice to reshape our hearts and align our will with His divine plan. Through prayer, we enter into the divine intimacy Christ Himself enjoyed with the Father, enabling us to be reconciled with God and with ourselves. Only when we are at peace within can we extend that peace to the world around us.

Fasting is not simply about abstaining from food or comforts; it is a spiritual discipline of detachment, a conscious renunciation of all that distances us from God. It is an act of emptying ourselves so that Christ may fill us with His presence. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches, fasting is meant to purify the heart, free us from excessive attachments, and strengthen our resolve in

spiritual warfare (CCC 1434). It is not an end in itself but a means to deepen our reliance on God's grace. Whether it be fasting from sin, from unhealthy habits, or from anything that enslaves the soul, it is only through such renunciation that we can draw nearer to the One who is our true sustenance (John 6:35).

Almsgiving, in its deepest sense, is an expression of divine charity. It is not merely an act of generosity but a participation in the very love of Christ, who emptied Himself for our salvation (Philippians 2:7). True almsgiving goes beyond material assistance; it is a testament to our belief that every human being is created in the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1:27). Through acts of mercy, we recognize Christ in the poor, the marginalized, and the suffering. Jesus reminds us, "Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me" (Matthew 25:40). When we extend our hands to the needy, we are not simply helping them—we are encountering Christ Himself.

In this Jubilee Year, our focus is especially on bringing hope to the hopeless and fostering reconciliation. Lent is a privileged time to practice these virtues in concrete ways, making visible the mercy and compassion of Christ in our communities. More than external observances, this season is a call to authentic transformation, leading us to a true conversion of heart. As St. Paul reminds us, "If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has passed away, behold, the new has come" (2 Corinthians 5:17).

May this Lenten season be a time of grace and renewal, drawing us deeper into the mystery of Christ's love and preparing us to celebrate His glorious resurrection with hearts purified and renewed in faith.

பாலர்சபை தினம் - பிப்ரவரி 09, 2025

கிறிஸ்துவில் அன்புமிக்க இறைமக்களே, அருட்பணியாளர்களே, துறவற சகோதர ககோதரிகளே, குழந்தைகளை அரவணைத்து அசீர்வதித்த நம் ஆண்டவர் இயேசுவின் அன்பும், அருளும், உடனிருப்பும் உங்கள் அனைவரோடும் என்றும் இருப்பதாக.

ஒவ்வொரு ஆண்டும் பிப்ரவரி மாதம் இரண்டாம் ஞாயிறை தாய்த்திருச்சபை அகில உலக பாலர்சபை தினமாக சிறப்பிக்கின்றது. அதன் வழியில் இவ்வாண்டு பிப்ரவரி திங்கள் 09-ம் நாள் ஞாயிற்றுக்கிழமை பாலர்சபை தினமாகச் சிறப்பிக்க அழைப்பு விடுக்கிறது. இவ்வாண்டிற்கென தரப்பட்டிருக்கும் மையச்சிந்தனை "இயேசுவின் இலட்சியப் பாதையில் பயணித்து நிறைவாழ்வு அடையும் சிறார்களாக" என்பதாகும். இந்த யூபிலி ஆண்டில் சிறார்கள் இயேசுவின் இலட்சியப் பாதையை புரிந்துகொள்ளவும், அதில் பயணித்து நிறைவாழ்வை பெற்றுக்கொள்ளவும் பயிற்சிகள், குழு ஆய்வுகள் மற்றும் சிறப்பு செயல்பாடுகள் வழியாக வழிகாட்டிட உங்களை அழைக்கின்றேன்.

குழந்தைகளை நேசித்தவர் இயேசு. குழந்தையாகப் பிறந்தவர். குழந்தைகளின் குணநலன்களோடு வளர்ந்தவர். தான் வாழ்ந்த சமூகத்தில் குழந்தைகளின் நிலையை உணர்ந்தவர்; குழந்தைகளின் மனித மாண்பை மதித்தவர்; பாதுகாத்தவர். தனது இலட்சியக் கனவான இறையாட்சியை அறிவிப்பதிலே, செயல்படுத்துவதிலே இயேசு குழந்தைகளை முன்னிறுத்துவது குழந்தைகள் இயேசுவின் நெஞ்சத்திற்கு நெருக்கமானவர்கள் என்பதைக் காட்டுகின்றது. "நீங்கள் மனந்திரும்பி சிறுபிள்ளைகள்போல் ஆகாவிட்டால் விண்ணுலகில் நுழைய மாட்டீர்கள் என உறுதியாக உங்களுக்குச் சொல்கிறேன். இச்சிறுபிள்ளையைப்போலத் தம்மைத் தாழ்த்திக் கொள்பவரே விண்ணுலகில் மிகப் பெரியவர். சிறு பிள்ளைகளை என்னிடம் வரவிடுங்கள். அவர்களை தடுக்காதீர்கள். ஏனெனில் இறையாட்சி இத்தகையோர்க்கே உரியது. இறையாட்சியை சிறுபிள்ளையைப்போல் ஏற்றுக்கொள்ளாதோர் அதற்கு உட்படமாட்டார் என உறுதியாக உங்களுக்குச் சொல்கிறேன்" என்று கூறிக் குழந்தைகளைப் போன்றோருக்கே இறையாட்சி உரியது என்று இறையாட்சியை ஏற்றுக்கொள்ள முன்வருவோருக்கு குழந்தைகளை உவமையாக முன்வைக்கிறார் இயேசு.

கடந்த ஆண்டு அகில உலக குழந்தைகள் தினத்தை முன்னிட்டு திருத்தந்தை பிரான்சிஸ் இறைமக்களுக்கு விடுத்த செய்தியில் "குழந்தைகள் பெற்றோருக்கும், குடும்பத்திற்கும், திரு அவைக்கும், இந்த உலகிற்கும் மகிழ்ச்சியின் ஊற்றாய் இருக்கின்றார்கள். கடந்த காலத்தையும், எதிர்காலத்தையும் இணைக்கும் சங்கிலிகளாக வளர்கின்றார்கள்" என்று குறிப்பிடுகின்றார்.

எருசலேம் ஆலயத்தில் காணாமல் போன சிறுவன் இயேசு மீண்டும் கண்டுபிடிக்கப்பட்டப் பிறகு அவரது பெற்றோருடன் நாசரேத்திற்குத் திரும்புகின்றார். அங்கு அவர் தன் பெற்றோருக்குப் பணிந்து நடந்தார்; அவர் ஞானத்திலும், உடல் வளர்ச்சியிலும் மிகுந்து கடவுளுக்கும், மனிதருக்கும் உகந்தவராக வாழ்ந்து வந்தார் என்று லூக்கா நற்செய்தியிலே வாசிக்கின்றோம் (லூக். 2: 51-52). அன்னை மரியாவும், புனித சூசையப்பரும் இணைந்து அமைத்த குடும்பம் இயேசு ஞானத்தில் வளர, உடல் ஆரோக்கியத்தில் சிறந்திருக்க, கடவுளுக்கும், மனிதருக்கும் உகந்த பண்பாளராக உருவாக ஏற்ற குழலைக் கொண்டிருந்தது என்பதை நாம் அறிய முடிகின்றது.

இயேசுவின் குழந்தைப்பருவம் அவர்தம் குடும்பத்தோடும், மக்களின் வாழ்வோடும் தன்னை இணைத்துக்கொண்டு வளரும் காலமாகவே அமைந்திருந்தது. அவர் தனது தந்தையின் தச்சுத் தொழிலைக் கற்றுக்கொண்டார். தந்தையாம்

இறைவனால் ஈர்க்கப்பட்டவராக அவர்தம் அலுவல்களில் அக்கறை கொண்டவராக இருந்தார். "நான் என் தந்தையின் அலுவலில் ஈடுபட்டிருக்க வேண்டும் என்பது உங்களுக்குத் தெரியாதா? (லூக். 2: 49)" என்று கேட்பது தன் குடும்பத்தோடு மட்டுமல்ல, தந்தையாம் இறைவனோடும், இந்த சமூகத்தோடும் இணைந்து செயலாற்றினார் என்பதை உணர்த்துகின்றது.

மகிழ்ச்சியின் ஊற்றாக, காலங்களை இணைப்பவர்களாக, இறையாட்சியின் அடையாளங்களாக விளங்கும் நம் குழந்தைகள் நிறைவாழ்வை நோக்கி வளர இன்றைய சமூகம் எப்படிப்பட்டச் சூழலை உருவாக்கியிருக்கின்றது என்பதை ஆய்வு செய்ய நாம் கடமைப்பட்டிருக்கின்றோம்.

நம் சமூகத்தில் குழந்தைகள் பாதுகாப்பாக உள்ளனர் என்று உறுதியாகக் கூற இயலவில்லை, குழந்தைகளுக்கு எதிராக வன்முறைகள் அதிகரித்துள்ளது. பல காரணங்களுக்காக குழந்தைகள் கடத்தப்படுவது அவர்களுக்கு எதிராக இழைக்கப்படும் மிகப்பெரும் அநீதி. குழந்தைத் தொழிலாளர்கள், பெண் குழந்தைகள் கொலை ஆகிய இழிச்செயல்கள் இன்னும் முற்றிலுமாக அகற்றப்படவில்லை. இந்நிலையில், நம் சமூகத்தில் குழந்தைகளுக்குப் பாதுகாப்பும், சம வாய்ப்பும் கிடைக்கப்பெறும் நல்ல குழலை அனைவரும் இணைந்து உருவாக்கிட முயற்சிக்க வேண்டும்.

நம் மறைமாவட்டம் சிறார் குறித்து எப்போதும் அதிகமான அக்கறை கொண்டுள்ளது. சிறாருக்கென மறைக்கல்வி, சிறார் அன்பியம், பாலர் சபை, சிறுவழி இயக்கம், இளந்தளிர் இயக்கம், சிறுவர் பாராளுமன்றம், விடுமுறை விவிலியப் பள்ளி, சிறாருக்கான நற்கருணைக் கொண்டாட்டம் எனப்பல வழிகளில் சிறுவர்களை சிறந்தவர்களாக உருவாக்கிடத் திட்டங்களை வகுத்துள்ளோம். இவற்றைத் திட்டமிட்டு செயல்படுத்த அன்புடன் கேட்டுக்கொள்கின்றேன்.

நம் பங்குகளிலும், கிளைப்பங்குகளிலும் வருகின்ற ஞாயிறை பாலர்சபை ஞாயிறாக சிறப்பிப்போம். அன்றைய வழிபாட்டில் நமது சிறாருக்கு முக்கிய இடத்தைக் கொடுப்போம். எல்லாரும் இணைந்து உலகெங்கும் வாழும் ஏழை சிறாருக்கு உதவும் பொருட்டு வருகின்ற பிப்ரவரி 09, 2025 அன்று சிறப்பு காணிக்கை எடுத்து அதனை மறைமாவட்டப் பொருளாிடம் ஒப்படைக்கக் கேட்டுக் கொள்கிறேன்.


