

Pope Francis: A Reflection of God's Mercy

Dear Fathers, Sisters, and All My Beloved People,

It is with a heart both sorrowful and grateful that I write to you in this month's diocesan newsletter. On Easter Monday, April 21, 2025, our beloved Holy Father, Pope Francis, entered his eternal rest. His passing is a moment of great sadness for the Universal Church, but it is also a time of deep thanksgiving for the life and mission of this extraordinary shepherd who led the Church with humility, compassion, and courage.

From the very beginning of his pontificate in 2013, Pope Francis showed us what it means to be a Church that walks with the poor and the suffering. He often reminded us that the Church must be like a "field hospital" for the wounded, offering healing and hope. His own life was a reflection of that message. He ate meals with the homeless, embraced the sick, visited war-torn regions, and stood in solidarity with the forgotten and the abandoned. Notably, he chose to celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper in prisons, washing the feet of inmates, including women and individuals of various faiths, embodying Christ's message of love and service. His compassion was never superficial; it deeply shaped the priorities of the Vatican and the global Church. He visited the island of Lampedusa in 2013 to mourn the migrants who had drowned at sea and used the occasion to call for a more humane and just response to the global migration crisis. He did not merely speak about the poor. He lived in a way that consistently put them at the center of the Church's mission.

But Pope Francis was more than a pastor to the poor. He was also a revolutionary leader who courageously led the Church through times of transformation. He spoke strongly against clericalism and brought a renewed focus on the dignity and role of the laity, especially women, in the life of the Church. He opened up Vatican structures to greater transparency and gave leadership roles to religious sisters and laypeople in ways never seen before. He encouraged a synodal Church, one that listens, walks together, and discerns God's will as a community. With great pride, I say that Pope Francis was a revolutionary Pope who challenged and reshaped many long-standing systems within the Church. He dismantled internal power centers and emphasized that true authority in the Church must be rooted in service, not in status. His simplicity and humility, even while holding one of the most powerful offices in the world, were remarkable.

Pope Francis was also a voice of peace for our troubled world. He tirelessly worked to promote dialogue and reconciliation between nations and peoples. He played a pivotal role in the re-establishment of diplomatic ties between the United States and Cuba and continually urged for peace in conflict zones like the Middle East and Ukraine. In 2019, he made a poignant plea for peace in South Sudan, kneeling and kissing the feet of the nation's leaders, urging them to preserve their fragile peace. It was a stunning act of humility and conviction that revealed the depth of his commitment to peace-building.

He was deeply passionate about care for God's creation. His groundbreaking encyclical *Laudato Si'* became a global call to

ecological responsibility, reminding us that the earth is our common home, a sacred gift from God, and that caring for it is a moral and spiritual duty. His message resonated not only within the Church but also among global environmental leaders, scientists, and activists, including those outside the Christian faith.

As we reflect on his life and mission, we thank God for the tremendous gift of Pope Francis in our time. His leadership, rooted in mercy, simplicity, and courage, has left a profound impact on the Church and the world. May we be inspired by his legacy to live our faith with authenticity, to serve the poor with compassion, and to work tirelessly for peace and justice in our communities.

With great joy, I also take this opportunity to announce the priestly ordination of two of our deacons. The ordination will take place on **Sunday, May 4, 2025, at 4:30 p.m.** at the **Cathedral of the Most Holy Trinity, Thirithuvapuram**. I warmly invite all our priests, religious, and lay faithful to attend this grace-filled celebration. Let us support our new priests with our prayers and continue to pray earnestly for more vocations in our diocese.

பசி, பிணி ஒழிப்பு ஞாயிறு

அன்பான அருள்பணியாளர்களே, அருள்சகோதரிகளே, இறைமக்களே! நம் ஆண்டவராகிய இயேசு கிறிஸ்துவின் அருளும் கடவுளின் அன்பும் தூய ஆவியாரின் நட்புருவும் உங்களுக்கு உரித்தாகுக!

யூபிலி ஆண்டின் தவக்கால தயாரிப்புகளிலும் அருள்வாழ்வு புதுப்பித்தலிலும் ஈடுபடும் உங்களை பசி-பிணி ஞாயிறை சிறப்பிக்க அன்புடன் அழைக்கிறேன். இவ்வாண்டு பசி பிணி ஞாயிறை "எதிர்நோக்கின் திருப்பயணம் : பகிர்ந்து பணிபுரிய" என்ற மையசிந்தனையில் சிந்திக்க திருஅவை நமக்கு அழைப்பு விடுக்கிறது. ஆனால் இன்றைய அதிநவீன உலகின் முதலாளித்துவ மற்றும் ஆதிக்கச் சிந்தனைகளால், மாற்றுத்திறனாளிகள், வறுமைப்பட்டோர், போட்டியிட முடியாதவர், நோயுற்றோர், புலம்பெயர்ந்தோர், இன, பாலின அடையாளம் மற்றும் அறிவு சார்ந்த குறைபாடுள்ளவர்கள் போதைக்கு அடிமையானவர்கள் முதியோர் மற்றும் தனிமையில் இருப்போர் என ஒரு தரப்பினர் இவ்வுலகில் வாழவே தகுதியில்லாதவர்களாக கருதப்படுகின்றனர். துன்பங்கள், ஏமாற்றங்கள், இடம்பெயருதல் இன்று அதிகரித்து வருகிறது. சில மனிதாபிமானமற்ற மனிதர்களால் வளர்க்கப்படும் வெறுப்புணர்வுகளாலும் கலவரங்களாலும் போர்களாலும் பெரும்பாலான எளிய மக்கள் மனிதநேயமற்றச் சூழலுக்குத் தள்ளப்படுகின்றனர். வறுமை, பசி, சாதிய மற்றும் பொருளாதார ஏற்றத்தாழ்வுகள், உடல் மற்றும் மன ஊனங்கள்,

போதைகளுக்கு அடிமையாதல் போன்ற சமூக பாகுபாடுகள் மனிதனுக்கு வாழ்க்கை மற்றும் எதிர்காலம் பற்றிய நம்பிக்கை அற்ற சூழலை உருவாக்குகிறது. நிறைந்த செல்வம் உடையோர் குறைந்த வரி செலுத்துவதும் குறைந்த செல்வம் ஈட்டுவோர் அதிக வரி செலுத்தக் கட்டாயப்படுத்தப்படுவதும் இன்று தலைதூக்கி உள்ள பொருளாதார வன்முறையாகும். யார் ஏழை என்ற கேள்வி எழுப்பி ஏழைகளுக்கான நிலைபாட்டையும் முன்னுரிமைகளையும் முன்னெடுப்புகளையும் புறந்தள்ளும் நிலையும் இன்று வளர்ந்து வருகிறது.

இச்சூழலில் "எதிர்நோக்கின் திருப்பயணம் : பகிர்ந்து பணிபுரிய" என்ற அழைப்பு, பிநூன்பு செயல்புரிய நம்மை தூண்டுகிறது. "நமக்கு கொடுக்கப்பட்டுள்ள நம்பிக்கையின் சுடரை ஏற்றி, திறந்த உள்ளத்துடன், நம்பிக்கைக்கான இதயம் மற்றும் தொலைநோக்கு சிந்தனையுடன் எதிர்காலத்தைக் கண்முன் கொண்டு, புதிய வலிமையையும் உறுதியினையும் பெர அனைவரும் உதவ வேண்டும்" என்கிறார் திருத்தந்தை பிரான்சிஸ். எனவே புதிய வலிமையும் உறுதியும் பெற நாம் பகிர்ந்து பணிபுரிய வேண்டும். பகிர்வு என்பது கடவுளின் உண்மை அன்பை பிரதிபலிப்பதாகும். நமது சுயஇலாபத்தையோ புகழையோ முன்னிறுத்தாமல் உண்மையான அக்கரையால் பிறூன்பு செயல்களால் கடவுளின் அன்பை அநிய செய்வது ஆகும். அன்பர் இயேசு சிலுவையிலே தன்னையே பலியாக தந்து தன்னை பகிர்ந்து அளித்து கடவுளின் அன்பை நமக்கு கற்றுக் கொடுத்தது போல் பகிர்வின் வழி இரையன்பைப் பரப்ப அழைப்பு பெறுகிரோம். மேலும் ஆயனில்லா ஆடுகளாய் இருந்த எண்ணற்ற மக்களுக்கு பரிவினால் பணிசெய்த இயேசுவின் இரக்கமுள்ள இதயத்தை பிரதிபலிக்கும் மனிதர்களாக உருவாக திருஅவை நமக்குத் தருகின்ற வாய்ப்புதான் இப்பகிர்வின் அழைப்பு ஆகும். இவ்வாறு நாம் பகிர்ந்து பணிபுரிய ஆறு முன்னெடுப்புகளை பரிந்துரைக்கிறேன்.

1. அடுத்திருப்பவரை அறிந்து கொள்ளுதல்: நம் பங்கில் இருக்கின்ற நோயாளிகள், மாற்றுத் திறனாளிகள், கைவிடப்பட்டோர், விளிம்புநிலையிலுள்ளோர், ஒரங்கட்டப்பட்டோர், வறுமையில் வாடுவோர், முதியோர் மற்றும் தனிமையில் இருப்பவர்களை சந்தித்து அவர்களுடைய வலிகளை வேதனைகளை புரிந்து கொள்ள முயல்வதும் அவர்களுடைய துன்ப நேரத்தில் நாம் உடனிருக்கின்றோம் என்ற நம்பிக்கையை

கொடுத்தலும் அவர்களுக்காக இறைவேண்டல் செய்யவும் வேண்டும். இந்த யூபிலி ஆண்டின் சிறப்பு கரிசனையாக கைவிடப்பட்டோர் மற்றும் ஆதரவற்றோர் இல்லங்களை சந்தித்து உதவிட கேட்டுக்கொள்கிறேன்.

- 2. உணவளியுங்கள் ஊட்டமளியுங்கள்: ஊட்டச் சத் து குறைபாடுள்ளோர்க்கு உதவுங்கள். சமூக உணவு கூடங்களை அமைத்து கொடுங்கள். தெருவில் வாழ்வோருக்கு தினமும் ஒருவேளை உணவு கொடுங்கள். உங்கள் இல்ல சிறப்பு நிகழ்வுகளான பிறந்தநாள் திருமணநாள் நினைவுநாள் மற்றும் முதல் திருவிருந்து கொண்டாட்டங்களின்போதும் கைவிடப்பட்டோர் மற்றும் ஆதரவற்றோர் இல்லங்களில் வாழ்வோருக்கு உணவுதானம் செய்யுங்கள்.




