



VOICE OF THE SHEPHERD

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we enter the month of October, we remember with gratitude and reverence the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi on 2nd October, the Father of our Nation and a true teacher of *Ahimsa*, non-violence. His life was a living testimony to the power of peace and justice. Before his time, no one could imagine that non-violence alone could bring freedom to a nation. Yet, through his steadfast faith in *Ahimsa*, the whole country was inspired to resist injustice in a new way. We succeeded—not with weapons, but with courage, patience, and love.

Sadly, our world today is still plagued with violence. Wars rage across continents, and the suffering of innocent people continues. In Gaza, the situation is heart-wrenching: children, women, and the elderly are being ruthlessly killed in airstrikes, homes destroyed, and lives shattered. The pain is unimaginable, yet the world watches, often powerless or unwilling to act. This moment calls for us to reflect deeply on the teachings of *Ahimsa*. We must embrace non-violence in thought, word, and action and pray for justice, peace, and the protection of the innocent across the world.

The Dicastery for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, having examined the petition of the CCBI, has confirmed St. Devasahayam as the Patron saint of the Laity in India through Decree Prot. N. 215/25, dated 16 July 2025. This is a moment of great joy and blessing for the Church of Kuzhithurai where the St. Devasahayam was born in Nattalam.

CCBI will solemnly announce this on 15th October 2025, during the Eucharistic Celebration at St. Mary's Cathedral, Varanasi, where the CCBI Commission for Laity will hold its Annual National Meeting. To mark this grace-filled occasion locally, we will celebrate a thanksgiving Mass at Nattalam, the birthplace of St. Devasahayam, at 5 pm on 15th October 2025.

St. Devasahayam's life reminds us of the power of unwavering faith. Though he faced severe challenges, he never wavered in his commitment to Christ. His courage, faith, and love for justice elevated him to the heights of sainthood. I warmly invite you all to join this celebration, to honor him, uphold his values, and receive abundant blessings through his intercessions.

As part of this jubilee year, we continue our pilgrimages to shrines and homes for the abandoned, destitute, disabled, and mentally challenged. At the diocesan level, we will have a one-day pilgrimage to St. Antony's Shrine, Chunkankadai on 14th October 2025, concluding with a special Mass at 5 pm celebrated by me. I encourage each of you to come, participate, and be inspired by this pilgrimage.

Finally, our annual diocesan retreat will take place in two batches: 19–24 October (first batch) and 26–31 October (second batch). This is a sacred time to rest your body, mind, and soul, to reflect deeply, and to renew your union with God. It is also a time to renew our commitment—not only to God and the Church, but to our diocese and to ourselves. Come with an open heart, and let this retreat bear abundant spiritual fruit.

May this month of October be one of reflection, pilgrimage, and renewal for each of us. Let us walk in the footsteps of the saints, embrace the power of non-violence, and allow God's grace to transform our lives.
